- B. Are not approved or disapproved by our belief or unbelief. (V 11-12)
 - 1. Judges 13: 5 and Romans 9:9-11

II. Our Response to God's Promises Matters (V 13-15)

- A. Our negative response leads to God's rebuke.
 - 1. Genesis 17:15-19, Luke 1:11-13; 18-20
- B. A right response allows us to enjoy God's blessing.
 - 1. Luke 1: 34-38
- C. A right response brings glory to God.
 - 1. Ephesians 3:20-21
