# Death From Sin Genesis 3:1-13, Pew Bible p. 2 October 12, 2025

## I. Our Deadly Desire (V. 1-7)

- A. We sin when we don't know God's Word.
- B. We sin when we don't trust God's motives.

## II. Our Deadly Response (V. 8-13)

- A. Sin makes us run from the <u>presence</u> of God.
- B. Sin makes us deny the judgment of God.

#### III. Our Living Hope (Conclusion)

- A. We must admit our <u>fault</u> in rebellion against God.
- B. We must trust in the <u>cross</u> of Jesus Christ.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read Genesis 3:1-13.
- 2. What was the serpent trying to test in Eve with his first question?
- a. Has Satan ever tested your knowledge of God's Word in order to get you to sin? How?
- 3. What about God's motives was the serpent challenging in verses 4-5?
- a. Has Satan ever made you question God's motive in commanding you not to do something? What did you do?
- 4. Why do you think Adam and Eve chose to hide from God (V. 8) rather than be honest with him?
  - a. Have you ever run from God because of sin in your life?
  - b. How does someone stop running from God and reconcile with Him?
- 5. Why do you think Adam and Eve blamed others (V. 12-13) rather than themselves for their sin?
  - a. Have you ever blamed your sin on others rather than accept responsibility? Why?
  - b. What is the consequence of refusing to confess and repent from our sin?
- 6. How can we guard ourselves against temptation today?
- a. What is Satan currently lying to you about and what does God's Word say about it?
- 7. Pray for our church members to guard each other from temptation and lean on Christ as our living hope against death. Come to the church prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6:00-6:30 pm in the Worship Center lobby.
