I. Righteousness and the Word of God (V. 1-5)

- A. Righteous people know the Word of God.
- B. Righteous people obey the Word of God.

II. Righteousness and the Protection of God (V. 6-16)

- A. Righteous people are <u>protected</u> by God.
- B. Righteous people protect others through God.

III. Righteousness and Wrath of God (V. 17-24)

- A. Righteous people are safe from the <u>death</u> of the wicked.
- B. Righteous people are safe from the <u>wrath</u> of God.

Discussion Questions

- 2. How did Noah know when it was time to board the ark, according to verses 1-4?
- a. What does that tell us about what God reveals to the righteous compared to what He reveals to the wicked?
- 3. How did Noah respond to the Word of God in verse 5?
 - a. What does that tell us about how righteous people respond to God's word?
- b. What are some commandments or warnings in God's Word that people today reject but the righteous obey?
- 4. What does verse 16 say about who was the ultimate protector of Noah and his family?
 - a. Has your faith ever protected you from danger? How?
- b. Has your faith ever protected people around you, as it did for Noah's family and the animals?
- 5. What do verses 17-24 say about the level of death and destruction that is associated with man's wickedness?
- 6. How can you live in the safety of righteousness today and flee from the death of sinners around you?
