

## In Christ: Walk in the Light

1 John 1:5-7

- I. Understanding that there is no evil in God. (V. 5)
  - A. Jesus is the light shining in the darkness. (2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 4:5-6)
  - B. Our Lord Jesus is pure light. (Matthew 17:1-2, Psalms 118:26-27)
  
- II. The light reveals the truth about us. (v. 6)
  - A. That you have been invited into the light. (Isaiah 2:5)
  - B. That you are walking in faith into the light. (Hebrews 11:6-7)
  - C. That you are walking in Christ's light. (Ephesians 5:8-11)
  - D. That God is not fooled by your false professions or prayers. (Hebrews 4:12, Proverbs 20:27)
  
- III. True light is revealed through fellowship. (v. 7)
  - A. If you are in the light, you will put others above yourself. (Philippians 2:3)
  - B. You will have the right attitude toward others. (1 Peter 3:8, Colossians 2:2, Romans 1:12)
  - C. You will not bind your life in deeds of darkness. (2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 6:14)
